A RELAXING DAY TRIP TO THE ENGLISH RIVIERA

Class 40 no. 40145 throughout

From the West Midlands we head for Worcester and the attractive line through Malvern to Hereford, then on the switchback route through Abergavenny to our last pick-up at Severn Tunnel Junction. After passage through the Severn Tunnel we turn south through Bristol into rural Somerset, then bypass

Weston-super-Mare. A cut through the end of Mendip leads onto the Somerset Levels, whilst after Taunton we climb to Whiteball Tunnel and enter Glorious Devon, speeding down the Culm Valley towards Exeter. Soon we come alongside the Exe Estuary, where bird life and boats vie for attention with the deer park of Powderham Castle. A winding run past Starcross leads to Dawlish Warren and the curve to the right onto the famous sea-wall, leading past Dawlish.

After a series of short tunnels we reach Teignmouth, turning then up the Teign Estuary to Newton Abbot. Only a few miles on we arrive at **PAIGNTON (1245 - 1645)**, where you may alight for its family attractions and the famous Zoo. The train will now pass from the national rail system onto the private railway for a run through outstanding scenery. The Dart Estuary is first glimpsed far below, but we then wind our way down to the water's edge for the last mile to the terminus at **KINGSWEAR (1315 - 1615)**.

Where frequent ferries (fares include a return journey on the ferry) from outside the station cross the estuary to **DARTMOUTH**,

SOUTH DEVON RAILWAY: Alight at Paignton and join the waiting road coach for the short trip to the South Devon (formerly Dart Valley) Railway, for a return trip on this delightful line. **Supplement £13 Adult, £8 Junior**
